This team reported a great trip. They visited River Jordan, our Champions Home in Kenya, East Africa. While at River Jordan, Joe Easterling, Associate Pastor at Mt. Vernon Baptist Church in Raleigh, NC held a pastors conference. I want to thank Joe personally for the great job he did. The pastors were very encouraged. David Wyatt, also from Mt. Vernon, taught "True Love Waits" to the youth at River Jordan. Thank you, David, for your heart to teach the young adults the message of abstinence. The team reported that the children at RJ were very happy and healthy. What a blessing it is to have the medical clinic on the RJ Compound. The Clinic is one of the many things that we have implemented in order for RJ to become self-sustaining in the near future. There is a great need for a centrifuge at the medical lab and for an extra room to be built for the ultrasound and xray machines which were donated by Samaritan's Purse. Please help us to pray for these needs. The closest facility which offers ultrasound and xray is in Nairobi which is 8 hours away. The team also traveled over into Uganda to see our ongoing work in the villages of Iganga. Our Project Director, David Cooper, and his wife Sandy were also on this trip. David reported that there was Muslim after Muslim that stood and gave a testimony of now being a follower of Jesus Christ. Wow, what a blessing to hear these great testimonies. We have completed the rebuilding of the homes for orphans and widows in Mawagala Village. The team also traveled to Buckaye Village, the next Village which we plan to rebuild. They were amazed at the difference in these two villages and at the

transformation that has taken place in Mawagala Village. I am pleased to say that we have now begun construction in Buckaye Village. That is what TTW is about. Transforming lives with the message of the Gospel. We use many different platforms to carry the gospel to the world. I want to thank all of you that were involved with our work in Africa. That is right, you might not be able to go, but your prayers and support make it all possible. Great is your reward!

January 12 was a sorrowful day for us at TTW. The earthquake in Haiti was a crushing blow. I personally was in Port-au-prince last October. To see the devastation was overwhelming. Our pastor friends and their families are safe. We praise the Lord for his protection of them. We are involved in disaster relief in Haiti.
