David and Sandy were truly blessed with what they saw and experienced with Agape. Next they traveled to Hyderabad to visit Bethany Children's Home. Pastors John Babu and his son John Moses of Bethany are going into the slum areas of Hyderabad and ministering to over 200 children. They are feeding these children three times a day, teaching them God's word, and making sure they have a place to sleep and an education. David and Sandy reported that they had never seen such poverty in all of their travels. They were deeply touched by Bethany's commitment to care and teach these needy children. David stated that he realized that the Lord is using our sponsorship program to literally sustain the lives of these precious children. For 50 cents a day, \$15 a month, you can also be a part of helping these underprivileged children. David and Sandy were so touched that they sponsored two more children themselves when they returned home. "After what we saw we had to. I wish we could sponsor them all". David said. Lastly they visited Christ Alive Care Ministries in Kerela. CACM is a partner that is caring for orphaned children in the beautiful mountains of Kerela. David and Sandy reported that the children and the staff were so loving. We need to pray for CACM. Because of government regulations they will have to move in the near future. They have a new place picked out and plans are drawn up for the new building. Please pray that God will provide the funds for this need. You, also are involved in all of this wonderful ministry in India. Everywhere we are ministering you are there also though your prayer and support. Thank you for caring about the Lord's work!
