### *Featured Project...Bellemue*

Bellemue is a village in Liberia, West Africa. It is in the Panta District of Liberia. Jackson Quenisar, the administrator over this project, is a wonderful godly man that we have worked with for years. He and his wife, Harriet, have fourteen children, most of them being adopted orphans. At Bellemue there are 100 acres of land that the village people gave to TTWM in order to build a home to help orphans in the surrounding area. Ken Dewitt, of Hands of Mercy ministries in California, has partnered with us in building a Champions Home on this land. The first phase of the project, a home in which Jackson and his family dwell, is now completed. Jackson has also planted rice and has rubber tree seedlings to help make this a self-sustaining project. The next phase, when the Lord provides the funds, is to build a dormitory that can house a hundred plus orphans. This Home will have great potential to reach many people for Christ, as well as provide shelter, food, and clothing for hundreds of orphans in this area. It is located strategically about 12 miles from the Guinea border. Our prayer is that one day the orphans we disciple in Christ, will take the gospel into Guinea.
