River Jordan Family Care is in the town of Bungoma in Kenya, East Africa. Pastor Patrick Walmawa, the administrator of River Jordan is a very godly man with a heart to care for orphans.

He and his wife Rosalyn have eight children of their own. There is roughly four acres at River Jordan with a girls dorm and a boys dorm, a church, medical clinic, sewing shop, primary school, as well as the home that Pastor Patrick lives in. This compound has chickens, cows, and a fish pond to help produce food for the 100 orphan children that reside at River Jordan. **One of the most pressing needs right now at River Jordan is**



**funds to buy books and lockers at the school.** Many of the children at River Jordan are sponsored through our Child Sponsorship Program. That means

that many of you help to supply food, clothing, education, and discipleship for these children. Pastor Patrick has a desire to become self-sustaining at River Jordan so he can duplicate and start another home to help more orphans. This home is one of our benchmark projects and we are so thankful for how the Lord has taken care of the needs through good people like you! **There are currently 17 children that are not sponsored at River Jordan.
