Sara is one of the 100 orphans living at River Jordan Champions Home in Kenya. Most of the children living at River Jordan have been orphaned because their parents have died of AIDS. Pastor Patrick Wamalwa, the director of River Jordan, writes regarding Sara:

"I got her when she was staying with her step aunt. She was staying under mistreatment. Her aunt was a drunkard woman and was even forcing her also to drink instead of food. During the time of eating, she was denied food and chased out of the house until they finished eating, then she could eat the remains. If there was nothing left she would go to sleep without food. She was forced to do all household work. She was also being forced to get married. As she refused she was forced to sleep outside the house. Due to poor conditions and lack of food she had scabies on her head and her legs were swollen most of the time. But she is now living at River Jordan Champions Home and is happy and praising God."
