We were able to talk logistics, look at the blue prints and ask many questions about this project. I am so excited about the possibilities of this school. The children of India so desperately need to have an opportunity to learn academically but also to learn about the ways of Christ. This will be a Christian school that will teach them about a Savior that gave Himself for them! Please join us in praying for the huge undertaking. May the Lord be exalted in India! We have also begun building a new Champions Home in

partnership with Echoes of Mercy in Kamuya Village, Kenya. This is just another step

in God's great plan of taking care of children at Echoes of Mercy. Please pray that all goes well as we begin this project.
