As we move into this year, only The Good Lord knows what He has in store for TTWM. As a member of the team at TTWM I ask you to pray for us daily. That is the greatest thing you can do.

## I ask especially that you help me pray for a few very special needs that are on my heart.

1. We have two homes in India that have recently been built and we desperately need at least \$1,800.00 per month, per home to take care of the needs of the children there. There are 200 children in each home.

2. We have acquired property in a very poor part of India to build a school to educate (in a Christian environment) 2000 children per year. We have the funding for the teachers, books, food, and supplies. We need \$165,000.00 to build the building. A comparable building in the US would cost several million dollars.

3. We have the property, staff, and organization to build and run a school in Kenya. We need \$85,000.00 to put up a school building for the children in this village.

For item 1. You may not be able to fully fund all the \$1800.00 for one of the homes, but maybe you can support one child for \$25.00 per month.

Item 2. While few, if any of us, could pay for the entire school building, you could buy a brick for \$.50, a hundred for \$50.00, drill the well for \$3,500.00, a piece of tin for \$10.00, a native worker's wages for a week for \$45.00. You see how this can be done. Item 3. This can be broken down just as item 2 was.



Thank you for your support. We will continue to serve until He returns. Remember, you are the ones that God is using to make this all happen.
