Their focus is carrying out Christ's Great Commission. Winning, disciplining, and counseling those who call in and listen to the 24 hour daily broadcast. This is a great ministry which Barbara and I support. They just finished their spring shareathon and met their goal of 5 million dollars. Praise the Lord. So far this year they have recorded at least 272 salvations. Praise the Lord. To help you appreciate the work of Touch The World Ministries, and the benefit of your investment in it I will share a few facts from just two of our ministries - one in India and one in Africa. While they maintain three children's homes that shelter, cloth, feed, educate, and care for the medical needs of over 300 children. They are also very involved in ministry and missions beyond the doors of the homes. Through the efforts of the staff there in just the last three months they have conducted several gospel meetings that resulted in over 40,000 (that's right-over 40 thousand) salvation's. They have baptized over 700 people, held 15 pastors conferences with over 5000 pastors attending. With only two doctors and five nurses they provided free medical care to over 7000 poor people. And they also did feeding projects in 35 locations in slum areas.
