Our loss, Heaven's gain! The impact he had on the ministry, the projects and the world (he trained and led numerous teams to the mission field) will only be realized when this age is over and the finally tally is calculated in Heaven. His heart was missions and he had a special heart for Africa. TTWM has numerous projects overseas that need funding e.g. four new church buildings, wells, school for 1200 children, plus many more.
